Dear Parents and Carers,

Milk



If your child has turned 5 in this month they will have to pay to have milk in school. If you pay now it works out at 0.210p per carton per day. Please pay as soon as possible so that your child can have their milk. www.schoolmilkuk.com



Please make sure you are signed up to class dojo. Any information about what is going on in school is uploaded as well as homework and other events happening in your child's class.

You can also use it to report if your child is absent or if they have an appointment by messaging Mrs Parker via the app. Remember to report any absences before 9am.

New Guidance on Isolation

The 10 day self-isolation period for people who record a positive PCR test result for COVID-19 has been reduced to 7 days in most circumstances, unless you cannot test for any reason.

Individuals may now take LFD tests on day 6 and day 7 of their self-isolation period. Those who receive two negative test results are no longer required to complete 10 full days of self-isolation. The first test must be taken no earlier than day 6 of the self-isolation period and tests must be taken 24 hours apart. This also applies to children under 5, with LFD testing at parental or guardian discretion. If both these test results are negative, and you do not have a high temperature, you may end your self-isolation after the second negative test result and return to your education or childcare setting from day 7.

Close Contacts

People who are fully vaccinated, or children and young people aged between 5 and 18 years and 6 months, identified as a close contact of someone with COVID-19, should take an LFD test every day for seven days and continue to attend their setting as normal, unless they have a positive test result or develop symptoms at any time.

We will be requesting seeing the results of PCR tests and LFT that children take. This is due to the fact that we have some vulnerable children and staff members in school.



Free School Meal Vouchers

Your child may be eligible for Free School meals and the holiday food vouchers that have been provided each holiday so far, if you are in receipt of any of the following;

- Income Support
- income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- the guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)

You need to apply online with the DFE 'applying for free school meals'.

So far this year Kirklees Council have funded vouchers during each holiday period for families for food and towards energy costs.

Nursery and Year 2 Parents

The online applications for those children in Nursery and will be due to start Reception in September 2022 is now open. This is also the case for the children in Year 2 who will be leaving us in July 2022.

You need to apply online through the Kirklees parent portal.
